Louise “Mimaw” Galloway (age 94) departed earth peacefully on Wednesday, November 18, 2015 in Charlotte, NC.

Louise was born in Alleghany County (Pittsburg), PA to Love and Blanche Osborne on June 16, 1921. She graduated from South High School, where she then had a long career as a Clerical Supervisor with the State of PA.
