Daniel Lewis Hunter, affectionately known as “Dan,” was born on December 25, 1943, and passed away peacefully on March 29, 2026, at Northeast Medical Center in Concord, North Carolina. Dan was a proud graduate of Reid High School in Belmont, North Carolina, class of 1962. During his school years, he was active in football, participated in the Glee Club, and even drove school buses—early signs of his strong work ethic and lively spirit. Dan was preceded in death by his parents, Charles Eugene Hunter and Clara Surratt Hunter; his brothers, Douglas Hunter and Samuel Hunter; and his sister, Mary Glenda Hunter Horsey.
