ELLA BRIGGS WILLIAMS, 74, OF CHARLOTTE NC, PASSED AWAY ON MARCH 19, 2023, FROM NATURAL CAUSES. ELLA WAS BORN ON APRIL 20, 1948, TO THE LATE JOHN HENRY BRIGGS AND LYDIA BYRD BRIGGS IN CHARLOTTE NC. AFTER ELLA GRADUATED FROM WEST CHARLOTTE

SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN 1966. IN 1968, ELLA MET ROBERT ALLEN WILLIAMS IN CHARLOTTE. ELLA AND ROBERT WENT ON TO HAVE 2 CHILDREN, SHEVVY ALLEN WILLIAMS, & LINDSAY LAMAR WILLIAMS, SHE

WENT ON TO STUDY CRIMINAL JUSTICE AT UNCC CHARLOTTE CAMPUS.

AFTER GRADUATING WITH A DEGREE IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE, SHE STARTED HER JOB AT MECKLENBURG COUNTY SHERRIFF DEPARTMENT

AND KICKSTARTED A 30+ YEAR CAREER. IN 2020, ELLA RETIRED AND

SPENT HER TIME ENJOYING HER FAMILY AND FRIENDS, CATERING, TRAVELING, SHOPPING, AND ADVOCATING FOR THE COMMUNITY OF HIDDEN VALLEY. SOME OF ELLA'S ACCOMPLISHMENTS WERE PRESIDENT OF HIDDEN VALLEY'S HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION. WHILE SERVING AS PRESIDENT ELLA WAS ABLE TO COMPLETE THE TASK OF GETTING SUGAR CREEK ROAD SHUT DOWN FOR THE HIDDEN VALLEY PARADE AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS. ELLA WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE CHARLOTTE BLACK POLITICAL CAUCUS AND ACTIVE MEMBER OF NAACP CHARLOTTE CHAPTER.
