Mr. George Gabriel, 76, formerly residing at 940 North Brevard St., Charlotte, NC, transitioned to Glory on Monday, February 17, 2025, at Novant Hospital. Born on September 11, 1948, in Charlotte, North Carolina, he was the eldest son of the late Geraldine Gabriel Jackson. He was affectionately known as “Gabe”. Gabe was a life-long member of Mount Olive Missionary Baptist Church in Huntersville, North Carolina. Gabe graduated from Torrence-Lytle High School in 1966, where he also played basketball.
