### LIFE STORY

HOWARD FRANKLIN BROADNAX WAS BORN ON SEPTEMBER 23, 1937 IN REIDSVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA.

HE WAS A 1955 GRADUATE OF BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL IN REIDSVILLE, N.C. WHILE SERVING IN THE U.S. AIR FORCE AND STATIONED IN JAPAN, HE MET AND MARRIED THE LOVE OF HIS LIFE KIMIE HOSHI.

HOWARD RECEIVED JESUS AS HIS LORD AND SAVIOR IN 1951 AND PROCEEDED TO GET HIS BACHELOR OF ARTS IN RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FROM THE INTERNATIONAL SEMINARY IN PLYMOUTH, FLORIDA.
