



## Isaac William Washington, Sr.

August 1, 1920 - June 11, 2016

Mr. Isaac William Washington, Sr., son of the late Ross Jacob and Alice Caldwell Washington, was born on August 1, 1920, in Union County, North Carolina. The Lord called him home on June 11, 2016, at Suncoast Hospice in Palm Harbor, Florida.

During his youth, he worked the family farm with his brothers and sisters. He was always working or playing. Everyone enjoyed his friendly spirit throughout his life. He completed high school in Pineville, NC. In 1942, the United States Army drafted him to service as Private First Class in Company E of the 354th Engineer Regiment (African-American section) during World War II. He was in France and Germany during the Battle of the Bulge from December 1944 to January 1945. By the end of the war, Mr. Washington earned the Good Conduct Medal, the European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with 3 Bronze Stars, the Marksman Badge with Rifle Bar, the WWII Victory Medal, and the Honorable Service Lapel Button for WWII. He worked for the Mecklenburg County School System, Southern Bearing, Color-Craft, Central Motor Lines, and Fruehauf. He retired in 1984 to pursue his hobbies of gardening and yard work. All of his life, he enjoyed a love of history and current events.

Mr. Washington was baptized at an early age. He was a member of Silver Mount Baptist Church for many years.

Mr. Washington was preceded in death by his wife of 45 years, Minister Irene Washington; five brothers: Willie Washington, Robert Washington, Sherman Washington, George Washington, Thomas Washington and Benjamin Washington; three sisters: Azlee Bridges, Elloree Potts, and Sadie Young.

He leaves to cherish loving memories his daughter, Marsha Washington Worrell and her husband, Scott of Oldsmar, FL, and his son, Isaac "June" Washington, Jr. and his wife, Margaret; one sister, Mary Lee Green; one aunt, Luvenia Faulkner; step-children: Middleton Gassaway, Raymond Gassaway, and Irene Tyson; one brother-in-law, three sisters-in-law, and a host of grandchildren and great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, cousins, other relatives and friends.
