James Edward Hamilton was born to the parentage of JC and Lurlene Hamilton on April 11, 1947, in Newberry, South Carolina. His education surpassed secondary education, but climaxed with him attending and graduating salutatorian from the New Jersey Institute of Technology. During his younger years, he joined the United States Marine Corps, where until his final days; he proudly wore his badge of honor, being honorably discharged in 1969, as a Vietnam Veteran. During his military tenure, he earned a multitude of medals and awards, including, but not limited to Combat Action Ribbon (Vietnam), Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal w/4 bronze campaign stars, Republic of Vietnam Meritorious Unit Citation (Gallantry Cross Color w/Palm), and the Republic of Vietnam Meritorious Unit Citation (Civil Actions First Class Color w/Palm). October 1, 1966, he married Julia E. Hamilton, and together, they raised and loved 2 girls – Tanyika and Florita. During his adult years, he became a member of the Masons, and began to develop a love for photography, and football (Baltimore Ravens to be exact) He was also blessed to give more love to his only son, birthed February 3, 1990 – Justin.
