With deep love and abiding faith, we celebrate the life of James Richard Nichols, who passed away on May 22, 2025, at the age of 31, in Charlotte, North Carolina.

### Born Into Light and Love...

James was born on August 29, 1993, in Silver Spring, Maryland, but just six weeks later, he moved to Houston, Texas—the city he proudly claimed as his childhood home—where his journey of joy, service, and faith truly began. James was the beloved son of Richard and Sonja Nichols, and a devoted brother to Richard Nichols III and Kayla Nichols.

### A Journey of Wisdom and Learning...

He graduated from Myers Park High School in Charlotte and later graduated from Morehouse College in Atlanta, where he proudly marched as a bass drummer in the renowned House of Funk drumline. He was also a proud brother of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, where he shared his passion for music and brotherhood. Following his time at Morehouse, James earned a Master of Arts in Christian Ministries from Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, preparing him for a life of faithful service and evangelism. He also shared his passion for God's word as owner of the Christian Bookstore at the Southern Lion, offering

Bibles and Christian literature to support others on their spiritual journey.

As the Director of Evangelism at The Park Church in Charlotte, James shared the Gospel with passion, empathy, and purpose, focusing especially on young adults and college students. His ministry reflected his deep belief that faith grows through honest conversation and meaningful community. He dreamed boldly, loved deeply, and led humbly.

### A Life Poured Out in Passion...

James's passions were as vibrant and dynamic as his spirit. A devoted car enthusiast, he found joy in the roar of engines and the sleek curves of his favorite rides. Music resonated deeply within him—from gospel and hip-hop to Japanese pop and heavy metal—each genre adding a unique note to the soundtrack of his life. An avid gamer and anime aficionado, James held a special place in his heart for Gundam, bringing those worlds to life through his meticulously crafted Gunpla models. His love of science, sparked in childhood, fueled his curiosity about the mysteries of life, while his vast collection of fantasy and adventure novels transported him to realms of wonder and imagination. Through his collection of jewelry and hats, James expressed his bold individuality, leaving a lasting impression on everyone fortunate enough to know him.

Most inspiring of all, James was preparing to fulfill his lifelong dream of becoming a missionary in Japan. His deep love for the culture and his desire to share Christ's message across borders reflected the heart of his calling—one shaped by compassion, lived with humility, and grounded in steadfast faith.
