



## Jimmie Sellers

April 4, 1951 - June 1, 2023

Jimmie B. Sellers was born April 4, 1951, in Charlotte, NC, to the late Eddie B. Sellers and Gladys Timmons Sellers. The Sellers had 9 children and Jimmie was the seventh child born to his parents

He attended the Charlotte Public Schools and was a graduate of West Charlotte High School in 1971. Continuing his education, he graduated from Johnson C. Smith University in 1979 with a Bachelor of Science degree.

As a young man he worked for Jack's Cookies. He had various jobs after high school. But it was a position with the City of Charlotte. that truly helped him pay for his college degree. Over the years he held positions at various Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools as a Parent Advocate. He worked at Tryon Hills, Highland Renaissance Academy, and Lincoln Heights Elementary School, before retiring from Thomasboro Elementary School.

Jimmie joined Berean as a little boy when he was invited to church by the Gray family. He was their paperboy, and they would not pay him on Sabbath. He would have to return early Friday or Sunday to collect the subscription. It was through this encounter he was invited to attend church with the Gray family. Soon he joined the Berean Seventh-day Adventist Church. As he matured, he served the church in many capacities. He was a choir director, a song leader, an usher, director of the children's choir, Sabbath School Assistant Superintendent, and he worked with the MV. He would occasionally

assist with the clean-up of the church for Sabbath, often visiting the sick and nursing homes.

He was preceded in death by parents, two sisters Carrie Foster and Katherine Coleman, and three brothers :Robert Sellers, Freddie Sellers, and Thomas Sellers. Surviving siblings are Garfield Sellers Pladis Sellers and Terry S. Hamilton also one daughter Dr. Candace S. Johnson as well as a host of nieces and nephews, beloved relatives, and friends
