



John Raymond McDonald

August 22, 1938 - January 24, 2024

John Raymond McDonald, age 85, passed away peacefully on January 24, 2024, with his family by his side at Atrium Health Carolinas Medical Center. John Raymond was born on August 22, 1938, in Woodard, South Carolina and was the son of the late John Anderson McDonald and the late Mary Foster McDonald.

After graduation from Plato Price High School in Charlotte, North Carolina, he attended Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte. In his junior year of college, he was drafted into the United States Army in December of 1961. John Raymond served as a Medical Specialist. During his service to his country, he received the Good Conduct Medal. Prior to his honorable discharge in November of 1963, John Raymond received a letter of appreciation highlighting his “high moral fiber and devotion to duty.” In 1962, he met the love of his life, Mary Arlena Davidson. They were married on August 3, 1968, at Our Lady of Consolation Catholic Church. To their union, two children were born, Hans Christopher and Melodie Nicola. Over the course of his lifetime, John Raymond was employed with Belk Department Stores, served as a Private First Class in the United States Army, worked with Carolina School Supply, Carolina Medical Center’s Cedar Spring Hospital, and Carolina Medical Center’s Behavioral Health Department. John Raymond was a member of Moore’s Sanctuary AME Zion Church before converting to Catholicism in 1996. At Our Lady of Consolation Catholic Church, he assisted with the OLC Men’s Group, was a part of The Rosary Society, and assisted

with the church's Girl Scout and Boy Scout troops. John Raymond was a friendly and jolly man who never met a stranger. Left to cherish his memory are his wife of 55 ½ years, Mary McDonald, his son Hans McDonald (Dagny), his daughter Melodie Johnson (Raheem), seven grandchildren Hans II and Jensen McDonald, Khaleel, Hakeem, Abdur Rahman, Safiyyah, and Daanyaal Johnson and a host of relatives and friends.
