July 22, 1968 - February 23, 2024

Marvin C. Chambers, 55, of Huntersville, North Carolina, a proud Veteran of the United States Navy, passed away on Friday, February 23, 2024. He was born to Christine (Pope) Chambers and the late Marvin & “ John” Chambers on July 22, 1968, in Springfield, Massachusetts. He leaves behind three siblings, Vanessa Chambers, Marie Chambers-Willis, and Staci (Rick) Rhodes. At the age of 19, Marvin enlisted in the Navy. He valued this service highly and attained the rank of AE2 (Aviation Electrician Mate), Petty Officer Second Class. As part of this service, he was awarded a multitude of decorations, medals, citations, and campaign ribbons: Navy/Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2nd), Navy Unit Commendation, Meritorious Unit Commendation (2nd), Battle & “E” (3rd), Good Conduct Medal (5th), National Defense Service Medal (2nd), Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal (2nd), Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Service Medal (2nd), Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (6th), NATO Medal, and Pistol Marksmanship Medal. Marvin retired from the United States Navy after 20 years of dedicated service. Following his retirement, he settled in Virginia Beach, but later called Norfolk, Virginia home. Marvin was an Aviation Electrician at BAE Systems Norfolk Ship Repair in Norfolk, Virginia. Marvin loved fishing, gaming, hanging out with his military family and friends, and spending time with his daughters, Joelle, Gabrielle, and Danielle. He enjoyed cooking, grilling, and was also an amazing baker. Marvin enjoyed listening to old school R&B, Blues, and old

Country music. His favorite artists were Prince and B.B. King. His sweet fur-baby, Mika, an Alaskan Malamute, was his sidekick who has been loyal until the end. Marvin will be remembered for his caring heart, mellow personality, dry (but surprisingly funny) humor, intense stare down (he would win any staring contest), and his kind eyes and smile. In 2017, Marvin suffered from a stroke while at work. Following the stroke, he moved to Charlotte, North Carolina. During his time in the Charlotte area, he looked forward to taking long, peaceful walks with his dog, Mika, on the local Greenway near his home. He would take pictures and recordings (and sometimes a selfie) of the natural scenery during his walks and share them with friends and family. At times, his sister, Staci and nephew, Raylan would see him on the Greenway while riding their bikes. Marvin was able to spend time with his mother, his siblings, and his niece, Aisha ("AJ") and nephews, Derrell, Tarie, and Raylan. He also had 2 great nieces, Amaya, and Tiana, and 3 great nephews, Derrell Jr. (DJ), Tre, and Kai. He loved his nieces and nephews dearly. We love you son, brother, uncle, brother-in-law, and friend. You will forever be in our hearts, and we will cherish your memories.
