Through his painting company Dean mentored and trained numerous painting crews over the years and considered them extended family.

He was a highly skilled player and competed in various chess tournaments throughout the region, where he challenged many advanced level players. He taught the game of chess to other players as well.

functions. For the past twenty years, he looked forward to the family reunions and the trips to different locations. In his leisure, he liked watching football, basketball, or catching a great movie. Dean enjoyed long drives through back country roads, stopping along the way at “mom and pop” restaurants for a country-style meal.

Dean is survived by his mother, Maybell Williams Hart, daughter, Mya Nicole “Nikki” Hart, siblings, Atty. James C.
