We also enjoyed attending Sunday school. I'm not sure we enjoyed going to church but it was mandatory. Our life changed when Phillip's mom moved to Curacao and my mom to England. You can imagine how sad we both were. Phillip soon began living with his grandmother who had just returned from Curacao and I stayed with my grandmother - I had to spend my days with my Aunt and my nights with my grandmother. We still lived near one another. Phillip and I were given chores to complete, which sometimes didn't get done in a timely manner because we would meet up and play. If you are from Montserrat you know well there would be consequences for that. However, one chore we enjoyed was churning butter on Saturdays for Aunt Sister to use for baking bread and cakes during the week. As we got older Phillip got more serious and focused on academics. Instead of playing he enjoyed drawing.

When my grandmother died, I moved to the US and Phillip moved to Canada. There were times when we did not see or speak to each other for years. But once reunited we were inseparable once again. Phillip would visit with me in Boston over the years and on one of those trips he met his lovely wife and the rest is history. Phillip was like a brother to me and bonds like those are hard to break. Phillip, I thank God for the time we have together. May you rest in eternal peace free from pain and suffering.
