



## Mr. Robert Nathaniel Berry

September 28, 1948 - September 20, 2013

Late in the evening of September 20, 2013, God saw fit to call home his obedient servant, Robert Nathaniel Berry, age 64. Hearing that call and obeying the Lord, our beloved transitioned peacefully and now rests in the arms of God. Robert, affectionately known as “Mr. B”, was born on September 28, 1948 to the late Rossie Lee Berry, Sr. and Daisy Carr Berry. He is predeceased by a brother, Gary L. Berry. Robert was married to Linda Dianne Anthony Berry of Kannapolis, NC.

Robert grew up in Mecklenburg County and was educated in the Public School System where he graduated from Torrence-Lytle High School in 1966. Robert joined the armed service on June 7, 1968 and was assigned to the 50 Ordnance Company of the 5th United States Army having served in the Vietnam War, 1968-1969. Upon expiration of his term of service on June 5, 1970, Robert received an Honorable Discharge and was transferred to the US Army Control Group in St. Louis, Missouri. He received a National Defense Service Medal, a Combat Infantryman Badge, a Vietnam Campaign Medal with 60 device, and the Vietnam Service Medal with one Bronze Service Star. He was a member of the VFW Post 7775 in Charlotte.

After serving his country, Robert began a short stint working at Florida Steele. Shortly afterwards in 1970, his long term employment began with the United States Postal Service where he remained as a mail handler for 42 years until his retirement on March 29, 2012.

We are thankful to God for his life and the times shared with him. Family left to

celebrate his life and cherish his memories include his wife of 23 years, Linda Dianne Anthony Berry; two brothers, Rossie Lee Berry, Jr. and Adrian M. Berry of Charlotte, NC; three sisters, Ida L. Perteet (Wayne) of Sallis, MS; Patricia B. Lowery (Clarence) and Katherine Berry of Charlotte, NC. A host of other uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces, relatives and friends, who loved him and knew him to be a real gentleman, will also cherish his memory.
