



Roosevelt Mobley

September 10, 1946 - March 1, 2026

Mr. Roosevelt Mobley was born on September 10, 1946, in Mecklenburg County to the late David Mobley and Selma Williams Mobley. He graduated from York Road High School in 1964 and later earned his Auto Body Repair Certification from Central Piedmont Community College. Roosevelt dedicated forty years of service to Art's Engraving in Charlotte, where he was a valued and respected employee. During his high school years, Roosevelt met the love of his life, Cathelene Mason. He was a defensive linebacker on the football team, and she was a cheerleader. Their young love blossomed into a lifelong partnership, and they were united in marriage on January 22, 1966. This year, they celebrated 60 beautiful years of marriage.

In retirement, Roosevelt embraced the simple joys of life. He loved traveling with his wife and family to Daytona Beach and Myrtle Beach, cheering on his favorite team, the Pittsburgh Steelers, and playing golf with his son and grandsons. For more than 15 years, he devoted his time to coaching Little League Football with the Police Athletic League (PAL), mentoring and inspiring countless young athletes. He was a former Mason, and member of Unique Lodge and Rameses Temple No. 51. A true car enthusiast, Roosevelt took great pride in his beloved Nissan Z-Cars and never missed an opportunity to talk about them. At a very young age, Roosevelt accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior. Later in life, he recommitted himself to his faith, pledging to keep the Lord at the center of his life. He was a lifelong member of Mt. Zion AME Zion Church, where he faithfully served in several ministries,

including the Trustees, Men's Choir, and Preacher's Steward for 28 years. Roosevelt was preceded in death by his parents, David and Selma Mobley; five brothers, Robert (Doug) Mobley, Bobby Mobley, Billy Mobley, David Mobley, Johnny Mobley and Willie James; and four sisters, Sarah Watson, Zoretta Diggs, Delores Briggs, and Betty Jordan.

He leaves to cherish his precious memory his devoted wife, Cathelene Mobley; his son, Reginald Mobley (Annette); two grandsons, Dontavious Mobley and Devin Mobley; three sisters-in-law, Francella Mason, Gloria Mobley and Lucille Mobley; two very close friends, Mr. Ellie Howard and Mr. Phillip Osborne; and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and countless friends who loved him dearly.
