Rosalie Wyles Johnson, born on November 19, 1928, in Charlotte, North Carolina, was the daughter of John Wessly Wyles and Evelyn Presley Murray. She pursued her passion for costume design, earning degrees from Margaret Washington School of Design in Washington, D.C., and North Carolina Vocational Rehabilitation. Rosalie attended West Charlotte High School in Charlotte, North Carolina. During her young adult years, she embraced the Catholic faith and received guidance from Monsignor Charles Gable. She became a devoted member of Our Lady of Consolation, serving as chair of the pastoral council and the evangelization committee. Additionally, she actively participated in Bible study, the Religious Education Initiation Council (RCIA), youth support group and received a certificate from Lay Ministry. Rosalie was married to the late Lester Alexander Johnson II, with whom she shared two children. Her hobbies included cooking, cleaning, working with children, and cherishing quality time with her family. After retiring from Kenneth Home Fashions, Rosalie embarked on a new career in floristry alongside her husband. They owned Johnson Florist and Gifts for over three decades, during which Rosalie continued to manage part-time operations for several children in the Charlotte community. Rosalie was preceded in death by her eldest child, Lester Alexander Johnson III, and survived by her daughter, Kathryn Ramona Johnson. Her legacy includes grandchildren Alexis Johnson Wood and Lester A. Johnson IV, and great-grandchildren David Johnson, Cierra English, Xavier Chatman and Amir Johnson.
