His brilliance and love for debate led us to envision a future as a defense attorney; he could argue anyone into submission, often leaving us amused, raising the white flag in surrender. Discovering his love for music in elementary school, he later pursued a major in Music Industry & Technology. A lifelong learner, Torree graduated from Rock Hill High School and chose South Carolina State University to deepen his understanding of the music industry. His educational journey continued with an Associate's Degree from Lake Land College with an educational accolade of Summa Cum Laude. In recent years, Torree tirelessly built his entertainment company, managing and producing talented artists. In 2020, he found his purpose partner in Erica Hairston. Their union brought him not only love but also four beautiful bonus children who he adored —Narrie Hairston, Kahlee Hairston, Josiah Hairston, and Shamir Majied. Torree is survived by
