### A Man of Distinction

Wayne Anthony (Tony) Moss, was called to be with the Lord from his home in Charlotte, North Carolina on May 29th, 2017. He took his last breath in this life in the presence of his oldest son, Malcolm Anthony Moss and his wife of 32 years, Jacqueline Waites Moss. His youngest son, Collien Alexander Moss and his grandson Malcolm Anthony Moss, Jr., were close by to complete the inner family circle witnessing a sweet spirit soar.

Tony grew up in a home filled with love based on Christian principles. He accepted the Lord at an early age and continued to develop his relationship with Christ throughout his adult life. He was an active member of Greater Providence Baptist Church in Charlotte, NC; Peace Missionary Baptist Church in Durham, NC; and New Hope Baptist Church in Danbury, CT. Returning to Charlotte, NC, Tony ended his Christian walk back at Greater Providence where he was a faithful member of Samson, the men's ministry.

Tony was born in Philadelphia, PA, the middle son of Cleopatra and Leonard H. Moss, Sr. He attended Philadelphia public schools and built a circle of friends with whom he remained close throughout his adulthood. Tony cherished time with each of those childhood friends during the last weeks of his life. It was also in Philadelphia where Tony met Jacci. The two became best friends and high school sweethearts. Together, they went on to raise two sons. They traveled, talked, loved, lived and laughed as a couple for 42 years. Tony represented the epitome of manhood in his roles as husband, father,

son, brother, uncle and friend. He served as a role model touching the lives of many who admired his quiet strength, loyalty and devotion to his wife, family and friends. He was a graduate of North Carolina Central University and a proud 40-year member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. He had a fulfilling and lucrative career in Information Technology, but chose to devote himself primarily to his role as FATHER to Malcolm and Collien.
